What does the Schools' Library Service offer?

- Termly loans to individual teachers – project loans, class readers and more
- An annual fiction loan to the whole school
- Advice on how to develop your school library
- Information about books, libraries and reading
- We have almost 80,000 books in stock, and buy new titles every week
- We work with schools outside Salford too – for further details please contact Emily Stock, Schools' Library Service Co-ordinator.

How do I access the Schools' Library Service?

- Check whether your school has signed up to our service – if you're not sure, just ask us.
- You can contact us by email at schools.library-service@scll.co.uk or by phone during opening hours at 0161 778 0936.
- We are currently open by appointment only, on Mondays and Wednesdays, from 9am until 4.30pm.
- We are open as usual during all school holidays except Christmas.

How do I order termly loans?

- If possible please use our order form, downloadable from our website.
- Order by email to schools.library-service@scll.co.uk or by phone to 0161 778 0936.
- Include:
 - o Your name
 - o Your school
 - o Year group
 - o Topic(s) required – include as much detail as you like, as we will hand-pick a selection of books to meet your needs. For details of big books, class readers and other sets please check our Resources List, downloadable from our website.
 - o Date required – please ensure you confirm a collection date with us, before coming to collect your books.
- Termly loans can be ordered up to a year in advance. This is particularly popular for class readers.

How many termly loans can I borrow?

- At any one time, you can have one of each of several types of loan – eg a project loan, class reader, mini class reader and author box, etc. Please see our “Termly Loans” sheet for a full list. All loans are subject to availability.
- Loans are usually stamped out to you until the end of term, but can always be returned sooner and exchanged for new topics.

What happens if books I have borrowed get lost or damaged?

- We will sometimes contact you to remind you to return overdue books, especially if they are required by another school.
- When books are being used in schools, we understand that some may be damaged or go missing.
- We never charge schools or teachers for lost or damaged books.

Do you also organise class visits to libraries?

- Our colleagues in Salford Community Libraries offer a range of free class visits to public libraries. Please ask us for details of who to contact for your area.
