Winton Library - Outside

This is the front of the library building.



We have a free carpark in front of the library building which you can use.



You can access the entrance to the building via steps which are located in front of the entrance, or via a ramp which runs along the front of the building.



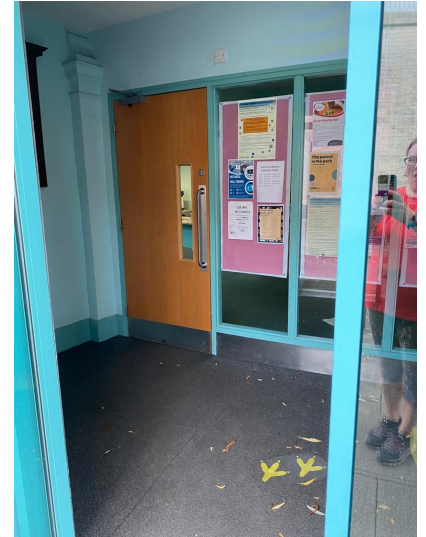
Winton Library - Entrance

After going through the main entrance door you will go into an entrance way.

This space has lots of posters and information on local events and library events too.

There are windows looking into the library.

Go through this next door to enter the library.



You will then see the library counter in front of you.

If you have come to use the Storynook or attend a library event, head over to the library counter.



The adult library, children's library and computers will be to your left.



Our community room and Sunflower library will be to your right.



Winton Library - Library Counter

Our library staff are here to help. This is Ian who works at Winton Library most days.

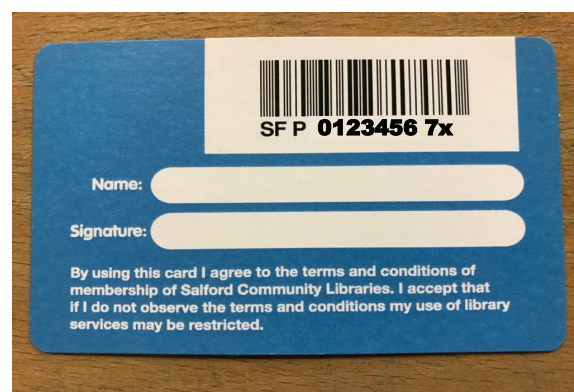
If you have any questions or need assistance, please wait at the library counter and a member of staff will come and speak with you.



You are welcome to look at the books and sit and read in the library.

To take books home you need to be a member of the library.

It is easy to join. Just ask at the library counter and a member of staff will join you up and give you your library card.



When borrowing books from the library, you can take them to the library counter where a member of staff will issue them to you, or you can use our self service machine.

A member of staff will be happy to show you how it works. Just ask at the library counter.



Winton Library - Adult Library and Computers

The adult and children's libraries are in the same room. This is a photo showing the adult library.

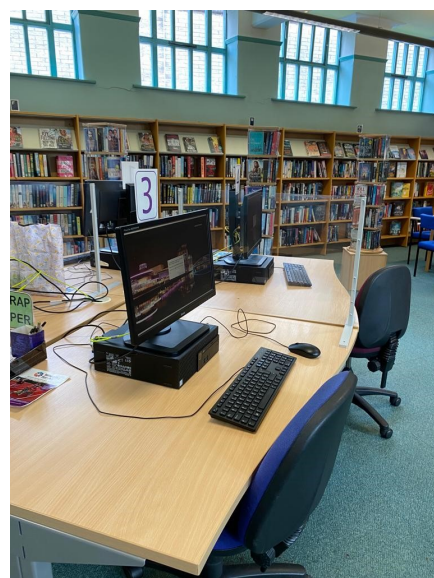
We have lots of books to borrow, including fiction, non-fiction, audio books, large print and more.

If you need help finding a book just ask a member of staff and we will try and find it for you.



In the adult library we have computers that you can use if you have a library card (ask a member of staff if you need to register for a library card).

You can also print from these computers. For up to date printing prices please ask a member of staff.



There is a comfy seating area in the adult library as well as a study area with a table and chairs that you are welcome to use.



Winton Library - Children's Library and Computers

The adult and children's libraries are in the same room.

This is a photo showing the children's library.



In the children's library we have computers for children to use. Children will need a parents consent to join the library and to use the computers. Please ask a member of staff if you would like to register for a library card.

You can also print from these computers. For up to date printing prices please ask a member of staff.

We also have tablets available for children to play games. No permissions or library card are needed to use the tablets.



We have a box of toys and some colouring sheets available for children to use.



Winton Library - The Sunflower Library

The sunflower library is on your right when you enter the library building.



It holds our more specialist collections including braille books, BSL books and sensory stories.

There is a table and chairs available to use.



If you need more space to share a story, we have a community room just next to the sunflower library. If you would like to use this space, just ask a member of library staff and if it's available they will open it for you.



Winton Library - The Storynook

When you arrive at the library please go to the counter so that a member of staff can book you in and sign any paperwork.

We will take you through to the Storynook and tell you where to find things during your visit.



The whole room is yours for an hour.

We will keep disruptions to a minimum but staff may need to walk through the room from time to time. If this is a problem, please mention it to staff when you book in.



There are different areas within the room with different stories and activities to explore. These will change from time to time as will the layout of the room.

The activities will be reset and ready for you to use when you arrive.

Staff are happy to help and we want you to enjoy your visits. So if you need us, please come to the counter and see us.



Winton Library - The Storynook

At the back of the room we have a seating area with a rocking chair, sofa, beanbags, floor cushions and blankets.

There are two partitions separating this space from the rest of the room making it calmer and quieter.

There are books on the shelves and different puppets and soft toys for you to enjoy.



Within the Storynook there are toilets and baby changing facilities. These are located on the left of the corridor, through the baby gate.

Please note these toilets are not accessible for wheelchairs. If you require an accessible toilet, please speak to a member of staff.



In the adult toilet there is a cubical with a lock, a sink, paper towel dispenser and a pulldown baby changing unit on the wall. There is a hand dryer in this toilet but it is not in use.



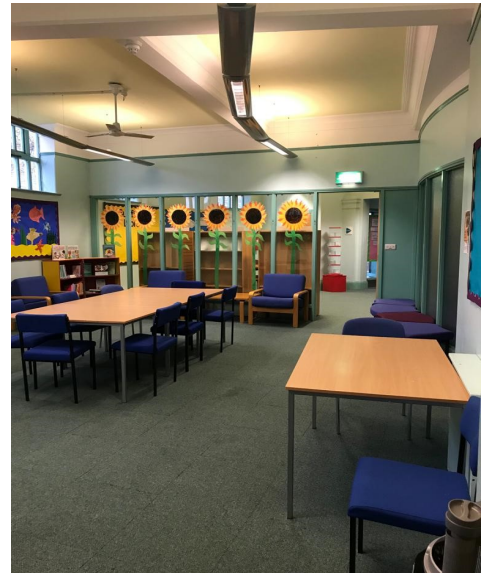
In the children's toilet there is a small size toilet in a cubical with a lock, a low sink and paper towel dispenser. We have a low table with a baby changing mat. There is a hand dryer in this toilet but it is not in use.



Winton Library - Toilet facilities

We have public toilets available, including a wheelchair accessible toilet, should you need them during your visit. They are situated within our community room. Please ask a member of staff if you would like to use them.

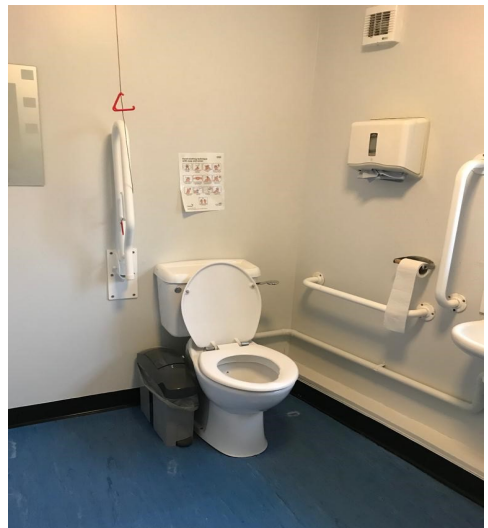
Please note: A bathroom emergency pull cord is also fitted within this toilet. If pulled it will set off a high pitched alarm which alerts library staff of the emergency. Please do not worry if this cord gets pulled in error. It is simple for us to reset.



The first toilet can accommodate a wheelchair and has grab rails around the toilet for support.

It has a low sink with a paper towel dispenser. A hand dryer is on the wall but it is not in use.

There is a pull down baby changing unit on the wall opposite the toilet and also a mirror.



The second toilet is not wheelchair accessible. It has a toilet, sink, mirror and paper towel dispenser. There is also a hand dryer but it is not in use.
